

# Kairos Community Lunch



Each Sunday afternoon at St Mark's Lutheran Church (downtown), local people in need know that they can get a free hot meal. The program is called Kairos Community Lunch (formerly known as Kairos Soup Kitchen.) Lunch is hosted by a cadre of dedicated volunteers including folks from 19 area churches, Westminster being one of them. It is an all-volunteer project, serving between 60 and 130 people soup, sandwiches and dessert. We recruit about 14 or 15 people when it's our turn.
