

Westminster Budget Narrative – Per Capita Assessment

Every Presbyterian Church is required to pay a Per Capita Assessment as established by the local Presbytery. These funds support the Presbytery, Synod and General Assembly as follows:

The local Presbytery receives 60% of the Per Capita Assessment and uses the funds for administration and to support its various functions including supporting churches and pastors, serving as a liaison between churches, communications and planning and serving as Board of Trustees for financial and property matters.

Our Synod receives 24% of the Per Capita Assessment and uses the funds for both administrative support and missions.

The General Assembly receives 16% of the Per Capita Assessment and also uses the funds for both administrative support and missions.
